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SLAYER HAUNTED BY DEEDS, KILLS WIFE IN PARK

C. B. Jackson, of Peoria, Leaves Note Saying He Shot His Wife and Baby and Feared the Gallows.

Haunted by the face of his wife and by the babe he killed at Peoria, Ill., Oct. 21, and by the shadow of the electric chair, as terrified as Charles H. Jackson, Jr., 23, slayer-boatman, finished the triple tragedy near Riverside park, presumably shortly after Thursday when he sent a bullet into his brain.

Standing on the brink of a 60-foot cliff when he shot himself with the same weapon he used on his family, Jackson's dying body turned toward almost to the water's edge. He had been dead about 10 or 12 hours when his body was discovered by hunters late Thursday afternoon.

A miniature looking-glass placed beside his body led police to believe he used it to make sure he placed the muzzle of the weapon at a vital spot.

Buried Here. Funeral services were conducted by John J. Collins, undertaker, at Elmwood cemetery Friday afternoon at 2. Jackson, the man's father, arrived in the city Friday morning to take charge of the burial.

Details of the double murder in Peoria were graphically expressed in a nine-page letter penned by Jackson to his mother, Mrs. C. B. Jackson, of St. Louis, which was found stamped, but unsealed, in his pocket. The letter was written in Memphis.

Two hours after Jackson's body was found Chief Burney received the following telegram from Chief Rhodes, of the Peoria police: "Hold Charles Jackson for local police. Wanted charge murder of wife and baby in Peoria lake. Letter received here today from him at Peoria saying he would be dead when it reached us."

The letter, which Jackson wrote to his mother, in part, follows: "I can't get away from the beautiful face of my young wife and the baby. They have haunted me ever since I shot them out on the lake. With the punishment of the electric chair hanging over me, I must end it all."

Shot Both. "My wife accompanied me out on the lake that day, and had the baby in her arms. I accused her of unfaithfulness, and she resented it. When I told her I would kill her unless she let the other man alone, I pulled my pistol. She was frightened and held up the baby as a shield. I shot her twice. She and the baby fell into the lake."

"She managed to grab hold of one of the oars, but I shot her again through the head, and she sank. They both disappeared next day, by fishermen on the Peoria lake at different sections. For five days they lay in the morgue unidentified, and finally friends came along who had known them. Police of Peoria say that when Jackson was asked by his friends about his wife and baby when he attempted to sell his furniture, he told them there had been a separation."

SUGAR CONSUMPTION RAISED 50 PER CENT. You people who are suffering from aggravated cases of sweet-tooth get this! The sugar ban has been considerably relaxed, and beginning Friday each individual will be allowed a 50 per cent increase in the amount that he can consume in a month. Retail stores may sell three pounds a month per person and can sell an entire month's supply at a time. Restaurants, hotels and other public eating houses are allowed a pound of sugar for each 30 meals served instead of each 45, as heretofore, and a portion of a month and a half of sugar may be served with each meal.
