

GRANDIDA, Miss., Dec. 5 (Sp.)—In view of the influenza that has been spreading in the city, the schools here were ordered closed for the second time today by the health officer. There were more than 200 cases among the students of the school. The schools will remain closed until about Dec. 20.

NEW COTTON REPORT

NEWBERN, Tenn., Dec. 5 (Sp.)—Director Sam L. Rogers, of the bureau of census, has announced the preliminary report on cotton growing in the county, which shows 7,000 bales picked from the present crop this year. The report for the year ending last year shows 6,500 bales picked up to Nov. 4.
