






NEW YORK, Dec. 4.—Although America has been called a nation of boasters, "we do not fully realize how great we have become," and how important a part the United States is to play in international trade after the war, declared Frank A. Vanderlip, president of the National City bank of New York, in an address here.

Speaking at the twelfth annual meeting of the American Association of Woollen and Worsted Manufacturers, Vanderlip asserted that we had won the admiration of the world and that this admiration would create a business atmosphere for us.

While admitting that "the labor situation is fraught with all sorts of unfortunate possibilities," he declared that the problem of finding work for the army of men thrown out of employment here by cancellation of war contracts would be solved satisfactorily.

Vanderlip characterized as "absurd" the wages paid in shipyards and munition works, and said they were bound to go down as time went on.
