SEES DRAMA AND SAYS "DYSPEPSIA" SHOULD BE TITLE

New York Magistrate Objects to Aspersions Cast Upon Fair Name of "Chaste and Monogamous Tiger."

NEW YORK, Dec. 17.—Chief Magistrate William McAdoo, who read the manuscript of "Tiger" in his study and then witnessed a performance at the Belasco theater later, issued his findings as to the morality of the play.

The decision was fifty-fifty. The chief magistrate denied the application of Police Sgt. Mark Horrigan and Patrolman Pooler, of the chief inspector's staff, for a court process against Frances Starr and Lionel Atwill, the leading actors in the play, but he was also requested that David Belasco, who produced the play, attend to the elimination of certain passages which the magistrate considered objectionable and suggested that the title be changed.

"The title is misleading and deceptive, and has proven so to persons who write me that they were attracted to attend the play by the well known artistic ability of Mr. Belasco in staging productions and the title which might be suggestive of anything in nature of art."

"It is also inappropriate, because the tiger is a monogamous animal, avoiding promiscuity, and, preferably speaking, chaste and reserved in its domestic relationships."

A little later, in his opinion, the magistrate returned to the question of the title and suggested how it could be changed.

I have urged on Mr. Belasco to change the title of the play. One of the characters says he is suffering from the tiger in his bosom, which all men have. Therefore, the title, the metaphorical tiger in the bosom, is not half so formidable as indigestion in the stomach.




