Senator Says Ideas Thousands of Years Old and Has Always Proved No Good in Various Trials.

NEW YORK, Dec. 29.—The theory of a league of nations is no new discovery, but it has been tried in various forms and failed at various times and failed of its purpose in successive ages, declared Senator James A. Reed, of Missouri, in an address at the dinner of the Society of Arts and Sciences here last night.

Senator Reed attacked the proposed league as a "parliament of man and confederation of the world," which, as he understood, is a sort of international organization for the purpose of maintaining peace and order in the world.
