

PATRIOTIC GOLF FEATURE OF 1918 YEAR

Champions Retain Titles While Quimet, Who Was in Army, Did Not Play.

CHICAGO, Dec. 29.—From a chronological viewpoint 1918 was a dull year in golf but what was lacking in tournament play was made up by a fine array of special matches in aid of the Red Cross and other patriotic purposes.

The Red Cross raised the amount of the Western Golf association netted \$200,000 and it is doubtful if any other fund raised so much money.

Chick Evans, of Chicago, retained the national amateur and open titles he won in 1916 and 1917.

For the first time in its history the Western Golf association failed to hold its annual tournament and event.


