LILY STILL CHOICE OF EASTER BLOOMS

The Easter lily again will prevail this year in the Easter decorations of the Memphis churches, due to the foresight of the local florists in preparing against the shortage that in many cities has made it necessary to use other

flowers. While the supply here is somewhat limited and the prices very high, the city is by no means without this flower, which in story and tradition since the first glad Easter has been closely connected with the resurrection of the Savior.

According to one beautiful legend, when the disciples approached the tomb of Jesus on the resurrection morn and discovered that He had risen, one of the number, pointing to the garden nearby exclaimed, "Behold! Pure white lilies have come forth." "And behold!" said another, "Where pure white lilies mark the footsteps of Jesus and the angels." Another story of the white lily re-

lates that when Joseph of Arimathea was asked when he would acknowledge Jesus, he replied, "When the red lily turns white, and the grass turns blue, and the sky turns green, then I will acknowledge the Christ." When on the day of the crucifixion the heavens darkened and the sky turned green, and the grass became blue, Joseph of Arimathea, working in his garden saw the red lilies turn white and falling to his knees acknowledged the Lord and prayed earnestly.

The Easter lilies used here this year are practically all home grown. All varieties of flowers will be popular this Easter and the demand is by no means confined to lilies, florists say.

Lilies and roses are being used together in many instances, with good effect. Only about half of the roses being used are home grown, the rest being shipped in mostly from Chicago. There is a plentiful supply of carnations and the white carnation is being used extensively.

Potted plants are especially favored by the public for Easter, and there is a good supply in the florists' shops, hydrangeas seemingly being the favorite.

However, the baby rambler rose, introduced as a potted flower this year for the first time by local florists, has won immediate favor. These tiny pink and red roses bloom in great clusters and are very beautiful.

Even though prices this year are much higher than ever before, there are to be found Easter combinations to meet the necessities of any sized purse from a few dollars to the elaborate baskets of lilies and roses marked as high as \$25.

MUNICH REBELS SEEK LOAN TO BUY FOOD

BERLIN, April 17. (By the Associated Press.)—The communist government in Munich is reported to have opened negotiations with Italy, by which valuable woodlands belonging to Munich would be pledged for a loan of one billion marks with which to buy food.

Late in March the former Bavarian government of Premier Hoffman and the Italian government were reported to be negotiating in regard to the delivery of food to Bavaria. Apparently, the communist government is anxious to reopen these negotiations.

SHOWMAN DENIES PART IN MURDER

Rufus Chitwood, owner of the "46" show at the Moss Bros. carnival on March 1, who is being tried jointly with J. J. Smith, his floor manager, denied on the witness stand Thursday that he handed a pistol to Smith a few moments before the shots were fired which caused the death of Jesse Campbell, one of the dancers at the show.

Chitwood and Smith are charged with the murder of Campbell. The state closed its case Thursday morning, but failed to place a single witness on the stand who testified he saw the defendant fire the shots which took Campbell's life.

The state is relying on circumstantial evidence to convict and its theory is that Chitwood and Smith conspired to take Campbell's life, that it was agreed that one was to lead a boy named Holland by a slit in the tent and that the other was to shoot him as he passed.

The state contends that Campbell passed and was shot by mistake for Holland.

Chitwood testified that he heard four or five shots but didn't see anyone but after the panic was over, started the dance going again. He admitted that he had cautioned one of the patrons of the dance not to dance with other men as it was against the rules, and asked Holland to talk to the other boys and get them not to use vulgar language in the tent. However, he declared, he did not anticipate any trouble.

He says he employed Smith the night of the shooting, but didn't know him and had never seen him before. Witness said he was born in Union City, Tenn., and resided at Blytheville, Ark., for 17 years. He said he had never been in trouble before, had never been arrested and never carried a pistol.

The state closed its case shortly before noon. Mitchell said Campbell died from a bullet wound several days after receiving it. Other witnesses for the state who testified were Clyde Mann, Bone Gantz, Theodore Hunn, county detective and Abner Holland.

Elijah On War Path And Sends Two To Doctor

Police and detectives were hunting for Elijah Mitchell, alias "Newton," negro, Linden avenue, whom they termed "Bluebeard," after compiling a list of things that Eli is alleged to have been guilty of Wednesday night.

Eli and Essie, his wife, having severed domestic relations, Essie left going to the home of her sister, Eva Brown, negro, 363 Foster street. Eli followed and according to the police report, this is a list of what transpired.

Eli caught Essie by the heels and pulled her from bed. Dragged her through the house and to the second floor porch.

Tossed her to the walkway below. Eva came on the run and crashed a bottle on Eli's head.

Eli pulled his pistol and toppled Eva over with a bullet through her left leg. Essie having suffered severe hurts

to her legs in the fall, crawled down the street. Eli shot at her several times, but missed.

Eva and Essie were taken to a doctor's office by Policemen Robinson and Oliver, and given attention.

Eli pocketed his pistol again and fled before the policemen arrived.


