## PREPAR PRICES NEVER-ENDING ECONOMISTS SAY

### Irving Fisher Declares Such Standard Is Not Justifiable Under Present Conditions in American Industry.

### PRESENT PRICE LEVEL IS HELD FUTURE CRITERION Inadequate Cost Figures in Many Instances to Prevent Close Prediction of Wage Scale Fluctuations.

WASHINGTON, May 21.—Reductions in steel prices, as announced by the industrial board of the department of commerce, at a hearing before the construction industry, are the subject of a statement by Irving Fisher, professor of economics at Yale university, who says that the present level of prices and wages, were the standard to be eliminated before a general program of building and construction work would be had.

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### There Are Exceptions.

There are exceptions, of course, but the department of labor and the department of commerce estimate that the girls who are willing to go home number not more than 10 per cent of the total who want jobs found in them.

## GIRL WAR WORKERS LONG FOR EUROPE

### Home Jobs Do Not Appeal to Them Nor Do They Like Life in Washington.

WASHINGTON, May 21.—The war workers don't want to come home. That is the one fact which has flabbergasted and amazed the employment bureau and United States chamber of commerce committee which have been working to place the many thousands of girls from all over the country who were drawn to Washington by the government's sudden pressing need for clerks and stenographers during the war.

Perhaps the best illustration, carrying the whole point of the idea which has upset the good intentions of the employment bureau, in the case of a big manufacturer in Gloversville, who wrote the employment bureau that he would like a private secretary, a good stenographer, would pay \$25 a week and permit very short hours.

At once the employment bureau sent the man a list of girls who were shortly to be let go, and were pleased as cream when they found a young woman from Gloversville, whose service with the government was about over. They had the case all noted for a prominent feature of their report until they heard from the young woman.

"That's the last place on earth I want to go," she informed the bureau, "give the place to some girl who has never been to Gloversville, and send me some place I have never been, so I can see something of the world. I would particularly like to go to San Francisco."

In a word, employment bureau officials have come to realize that the girls are trying to use the bureau, as far as possible, as a substitute for the Cook's four agencies. They have had a taste of travel and adventure, and they want some more. They do not want to go back and settle down to the life they knew before coming to Washington, even if wages and conditions are better.

Notwithstanding these developments, there are many in industry who have been urging wage reductions. They have been enough so that agitation to create an uneasiness in the ranks of labor unions in the minds of prospective builders and contractors. For this reason the precedent established by the industrial board of the department of commerce in the steel case should have a very beneficial effect. On the wage matter, in the statement announcing the new prices on steel, the board says:

It is fully understood and expected that the present wage rates or agreements will not be interfered with by the approved prices having this in view.

and those who talk of prewar wage scales under present currency conditions ignore entirely the fact that we do not have prewar dollars and we will not have them for many years to come. The department of labor holds that wage scales have less to do with construction and manufacturing costs than efficiency of labor. Investigations in this field suggest a gradual improvement in efficiency of labor as the adjustment progresses and industry gets away from the high-speed, forced-production regime incident to war. Mr. Morton Chase Tuttle, who served as production manager for the U. S. Emergency Fleet corporation, in a recent interview for the Christian Science Monitor called attention to this improvement in efficiency. The Monitor says:

"That a reduced wage scale is not indispensable preliminary to resumption of activities in the building trades is the opinion of Mr. Morton Chase Tuttle who has returned to Boston after more than a year of service as production manager for the U. S. Emergency Fleet corporation. Mr. Tuttle bases his judgment on recent investigations of large construction enterprises under his direction by a construction bureau in Boston, of which he is chief. Increased efficiency of labor is being checked down even while wages remain at existing standards."

"In the course of viewing numerous undertakings more or less closely associated with the interests of the government," says Mr. Tuttle, "I have been lately impressed to find the statement commonly made that cost of operation was beginning to show noticeable decline. And this, almost without exception, was attributed to increased efficiency of the labor force, due in part to the opportunity for weeding out the less dependable workers, in part to the growing desire of all members of the force to retain their jobs."

WASHINGTON, May 21.—German preparations for re-entering world markets proceeded vigorously in many lines of trade despite the social and political unrest disturbing the country, according to an official report to the bureau of foreign and domestic commerce. #### CITY-GROWN BERRIES.
