EDDIE CICOTTE'S ONE OF SIX BEST MAJOR HURLERS Miller Huggins Praises Work of Shine Ball Artist of Chicago White Sox and Pays Him High Compliment.

CHICAGO, Aug. 1.—Scarcely less remarkable than the same saboteur's sensational rise to fame in the twilight of his career is the comeback which is now in process of development by Eddie Cicotte.

Cicotte has already won 19 games while losing only four and other than the slightest sign of slowing down. Indeed, the game he pitched against the Yankees recently in which he scored a 2-1 triumph over the tourists, was in some respects the best he has shown all season.

Only twice did the Yankees even threaten to break through his air-tight defense. At the opening of hostilities, Roger Peckinpaugh drove a hard-hit grounder to McMullin and arrived at first base ahead of the throw. He went to second on Baker's infield out, but was left stranded there when Lewis reached first base thereafter until the seventh, in which Pipp led off with a double and, look third, on Baker's long fly to right, and scored a home run on Lewis' single to center.
