FASTER HANDLING OF CARS ASSURED

Committees Receive Co-operation of Business and Railroad Men.

The freight car conservation committee, organized Tuesday, lost no time in starting its activities, several of the subcommittees beginning their work Tuesday afternoon, and meeting with the most encouraging success.

Walter S. Shipley, general agent for the Southern, and F. C. Johnson, division freight agent for the Louisville and Nashville, called on several of the officials of the railroad and on several of the commercial bodies of the city.

The railway officials said that they had been doing all that they could to promote the prompt handling of cars in the yards and to the switching of empties and loads to and from the shippers, but they appreciated the efforts of the committee and would renew their efforts for still greater efficiency.

The committee continued its work of calling on railroad officials and other commercial organizations Wednesday. A. J. Werns, division freight agent for the Southern, and chairman of the sub-committee calling on brokers and warehouse men, also met with most encouraging premises of co-operation.

It is hoped that the entire field may be canvassed this week, so that the committee may devote their time next week to perfecting their plans for loading the various commodities so as to get the greatest tonnage in the cars, and to devising plans for handling in the switching of cars and making up of trains.
