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

COHN OFFERS TO PROVE INNOCENCE

Attorney Asks Immediate Action on Charges of Unethical Conduct.

Abe Cohn, attorney, against whom disbarment proceedings have been authorized by a resolution passed at a meeting of the bar association, has written a letter to Judge Thomas M. Scruggs, asking that the committee take immediate action. Mr. Cohn says he will not require the committee to prove him guilty of any unethical act, but that he stands ready to establish his innocence.

His letter to Judge Scruggs follows: "On Oct. 6, 1919, at a meeting of the Memphis Bar association, you were instructed to bring action in a court of competent jurisdiction that a full and complete hearing might be had as to whether my actions in the case of Tony Elardo should warrant my disbarment."

"In view of the fact that I feel that there are motives behind this prosecution beyond your committee's commendable one of keeping the legal profession true to its high ethics, I ask and respectfully insist that you gentlemen proceed immediately to bring action against me that I may have, in justice to myself, an opportunity to fully answer the insidious campaign now being directed against me by forces foreign to the high motives of the Bar association itself."

"Before any court of competent jurisdiction I am prepared not simply to dwell upon my constitutional rights that you prove the charges against me, but am prepared to demonstrate and prove my innocence of any illegal or unethical practice."


ARMY LIFE PRAISED AS PEERLESS BODY BUILDER
