MEMPHIS ONLY DIXIE CITY SHOWING GAINS

For the week ending March 24 Memphis was the only city in Dixie to show an increase in debts against individual bank accounts, according to figures announced by the federal reserve board through the Chamber of Commerce. The figures show Memphis debts total \$28,821,000, an increase of \$15,000,000 over the same week in 1919.

MARINES HAVE CHANCE FOR SPECIAL TRAINING

An opportunity to take a course in vocational training or to learn a highly paid mechanical trade at the expense of the government, and at the same time become a member of the Fifth regiment of marines, famous regiment of the war which helped save Paris at the Chateau Thierry sector actions, is offered by a new recruiting order of the United States marine corps. The order specifies that for a period of one month beginning April 1 a special class of recruits will be accepted for duty with the Fifth regiment, which is stationed at Quantico, Va., where a marine school providing for vocational and technical training is located.

Recruits accepted in this class must be of the highest type and have the best qualifications as to physique and character. They are to be attached to the expeditionary brigade, stationed at Quantico, of which the Fifth regiment is a part. This brigade is made up of picked men from the marine corps, held in readiness and in constant training for war or expeditionary duty. In case of emergency they are the first marines to be sent to the front.

While at Quantico they are afforded an opportunity of enrolling in school there. Classes occupy the entire afternoon every day of the week except Saturday and Sunday, which are holidays, all military drill and duty being performed in the morning. Most of the subjects usually taught in a grammar

school, high school and business college are taught at Quantico, and in addition special courses are given which fit men to become specialists and experts at a number of highly paid trades and professions, such as automobile engineering, electrical engineering, contracting and construction engineering, carpentry, blacksmithing, brick, stone and concrete masonry and a number of others.

Application for enrollment in the marines may be made at the recruiting office, room 19, Odd Fellows' building.
