

Character Builders Get \$5,000 Donation

Joseph R. Hyde, founder and organizer of the Character Builder Billie class, announced to the class executive committee, Friday an additional gift of \$5,000 to the building fund of the new Character Builder hall.

Last year on July 14, the Character Builders raised over \$40,000 in a single day to build a hall of sufficient size and properly equipped to accommodate the rapidly growing class. Since then the building costs have advanced, so much that the funds raised were not sufficient to complete the building the class proposed to erect.

Facing the alternative of cutting down on the plans or raising more money to finance the enterprise, the executive committee unanimously decided to submit to the members of the class only an opportunity to make free will offerings to make up the deficiency in the funds. Sunday, June 27, has been set for this offering. Mr. Hyde set the pace immediately with his gift of \$5,000.

Recent estimates call for a total investment of \$84,500 for the cost of the property, new building and equipment, so that \$29,500 additional will be required to carry out present plans.

MEMPHIAN ON BOARD TO REPRESENT SHIPPERS

J. B. McGinnis, Jr., Commissioner for

the Memphis Merchants' exchange, has been named a member of a committee of shippers to represent shippers of the National Industrial Traffic League, an organization covering the entire United States, in all matters pertaining to the proposed increase in freight rates, hearing on which will be held by the interstate commerce commission in Washington, beginning Monday. The Eastern, Western and Southern territories are each represented by three men on the committee.

This committee was appointed at a meeting of the national organization in Chicago, which closed Thursday, and

the distinction of membership on this select committee with the responsibility for acting for the entire body was a notable recognition of Mr. McGinnis' ability as a rate expert. Mr. McGinnis returned from Chicago Friday and will leave Monday for Washington to attend the rate hearing.

It will be the policy of the special committee, according to an agreement reached in Chicago, Mr. McGinnis said, to advocate that the intrastate rates be advanced to the same amount as the interstate rates; that the advance be made on freight rates alone and that no increase in passenger rates be made; to oppose any advance in switching charges; and that the existing rate relationships be recognized and disturbed as little as possible.


