U. S. SPENDS TWENTY BILLIONS ON LUXURIES Houston Says One-Twentieth Goes for Candy.

One billion dollars for candy and twenty billion dollars for things classed as luxuries is what the people of the United States are spending this year, according to treasury department estimates.

Secretary of the Treasury Houston told New York bond dealers at a luncheon of the Bond club recently.

He called for control of expenditures not only by individuals, but by federal, state, municipal and county governments as the chief means of combating the existing high price situation.

Present indications, the secretary said, were that world conditions were tending to improve and a movement toward the normal in progress.

Resuming his analysis of popular expenditures which tended to force prices up, Secretary Houston pointed out that the treasury estimate of this year's consumption of soft drinks and beverages in which much sugar is used is \$300,000,000, of cigars, \$200,000,000, and of jewelry between \$100,000,000 and \$200,000,000.

While government bonds are selling at prices which yield five and a half to six per cent, it is high time that the masses of the people were putting away some of their unusual earnings in government securities.

Those who fritter away the high earnings and large profits of these days are likely to see the time when they will suffer for lack of the money they are squandering.

The country's economic and financial joy ride is almost over and the time is not far distant when the prodigal will have to fill himself with husks.
