

### GOLD SNAP PLAYS HAVOC WITH BIG ARMISTICE EVENTS

The touch of winter which visited Memphis Thursday afternoon played havoc with the program for the Armistice day celebration at the Tri-State fairgrounds. Attendance was lessened and it was too chilly to unwork much enthusiasm. As a consequence the celebration was purely informal and much of the program curtailed.

Mayor Paine presided and Capt. G. T. Fitzhugh revived the events which led the United States to align herself with the allies in the war for freedom. His speech was frequently punctuated with applause. Mrs. Virginia Fraser Boyle read one of her poems that received an enthusiastic reception. The cold became so great that Senator McClellan's speech was abandoned. Senator John Sharp Williams was unable to be present owing to late arrival of his train.

The elaborate display of fireworks was also given up. All was in readiness but the crowd had thinned out so greatly that it was thought best to abandon that feature. Despite the chill of the evening Layne & Bowler's band rendered stirring music that was heard with delight. It is to be regretted that the ex-servicemen who planned and carried out the celebration will lose heavily, and be compelled to draw upon the funds of their organization to make up the deficit which, it is estimated, will reach a large figure.

### Buntyn Community Inaugurates Drive To Locate College

Citizens of Buntyn are very much in earnest about the location of the Southwestern Presbyterian college in the Buntyn-Normal community, and are organizing to keep their proposals constantly in the attention of the university trustees until the selection of the site is finally determined. Several desirable sites are available in the vicinity of Buntyn, all of which will be presented for the consideration of the committee on location.

Dr. A. A. Kincaid, president of the Normal school, presided at a mass meeting, held Thursday night in the auditorium of the school, where committees were appointed and plans laid for a campaign to raise \$25,000 to apply on the purchase of a suitable location to offer the new college.
