Auditor Osborne, of Mills county was in the city yesterday interviewing Judge Loubfrow concerning a mandamus, directing the county board of supervisors to levy a tax to meet the \$20,000 judgment in the swamp land cases, which have been carried to the United States supreme court by the railways and decided against the county.

The county supervisors did not feel positive about their authority to levy the tax, and hence a mandamus was issued. Mills county is pretty good trim financially, there being only \$5,000 of debt to wipe out, and this judgment, which will soon be paid off, when the county will be out of debt.
