Events of the Day at the Capital of the State.

Juvenile Soldiers in Competitive Drill at the College.

The Railroad Commissioners Organize--Commiss Notes--Deli quent Counties to be Called on for Taxes.

THE STATE CAPITAL.

AMATEUR SOLDIERS.

Reported by THE BEE'S BUREAU. LINCOLN, Neb., June 9.--The competitive prize drill between companies A and B of the university students, took place at the drill grounds to day, Capt. G. O. Hoarn, of company A, and Capt. Force, of company B, commanding their respective companies. The schedule called for eighty movements, and each company was allowed forty-five minutes for the exercise. The boys did remarkably well, considering that they began drilling only on April 27th. The inspector and judges were all ex-officers of the volunteers. The tactics have changed since the war. Three out of the four judges and the inspecting officer were smoking fragrant havanas while on duty. The men in whose presence the young soldiers moved were: Inspecting officer in full uniform and sabre, Capt. Derby, of Bennett; judges, Lieut.-Col. A. W. Cole, of the State Guards, and department commander of the Grand Army of the Republic; Maj. McClair, and Capt. Baird, of Lincoln, and Col. Phillips, of Beatrice.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSIONERS ORGANIZE. The railroad commissioners have held their first meeting, and organized by electing Secretary of State Green chairman, and appointing H. M. Warring, of Seward, as stenographer and book-keeper. As there was no business to transact, the session was short, and the secretaries were instructed that they would be in session all the time. The secretaries occupy the room opposite the clock room of the representative hall, and it is now being fitted up for them. The desk used by them will be one which the present secretary of state has worked at for the past fifteen years.

THE FIRST ASSISTANT, BRAD P. COOK, is in work above his elbows, trying to answer questions asked by some of the different enumerators. One asks if he shall put pig in the swine or the cattle column. Charles M. Hovey, one of the enumerators in the second ward, in Lincoln, is the first to turn in his portfolio. The cost of taking the enumeration will average about thirty dollars for each precinct in the state.

STIRRING UP DELINQUENT COUNTIES. The attorney-general is preparing to bring suit against each county in the state that is delinquent on the income tax and he has determined that no guilty delinquent shall escape. As Douglas county is owing the largest amount she will probably be served first. Her indebtedness to the state on the income tax fund is over \$38,000. The indebtedness of other counties is as follows: Lancaster, \$27,123; Cass, \$11,295; Dodge, \$10,131; Otoe, \$14,961; Richardson, \$18,844; Saunders, \$10,793. The other counties from \$21.545 which was delinquent to the state last November. It might be thought that the organizing board now in session to make a levy to meet this tax in their various counties, as the supreme court has already decided that this is a legal tax, and that the attorney-general shall push the matter if no provision to meet it comes trouble. If this tax can be collected annually there will be no further need of legislative appropriations for the income.

ANOTHER NEW BOARD MEETS. The board of public lands and buildings held their first meeting yesterday under the new law by which the governor is made president and the commissioner secretary. The board ordered the school lands in Kays Park county to be appraised. They are also preparing to sell the old Gillette property which was taken on a judgment several years ago for \$4,500. They will sell for \$11,000 for \$20,000 and perhaps more. The board also adopted a resolution instructing the attorney-general to take such steps as he may deem necessary to cancel or establish a forfeiture of the lessor to the Saline lands which do not expire until 1887.

THE BOARD has determined not to spend a dollar of the \$50,000 appropriated by the last legislature for the state seal and clear title and possession to the lands. B. H. Busby, with three cars of French Norman stallions and mares, bound for Kearny, stopped here yesterday. M. J. Hull, of Edgar, one of the regents, accompanied by his wife and daughter, is in the city. J. W. Deary, Bloomington; A. B. Ball, Tecumseh; J. F. Atkin, Omaha; G. Babson, Jr., Seward; J. M. Hatt, Alma; J. H. Waldeman, Weeping Water; L. D. Dent, Hastings; M. Holbrook, Mo. Valley; John Lauban, Crete; I. B. Evans, Omaha, and Senator Sherwin, of Dodge county, are among the visitors to Lincoln.

THE PRIZES awarded to the university cadets were a sword to Capt. G. O. Hoarn, of company A, for the best equipped, most decorous and largest company during the term. Company A received the prize banner as the best drilled. Private Walters, of company A, received the medal as the best drilled private. F. W. Kramer, of company B, took second prize. In the artillery drill company B was awarded first prize and Private J. G. Smith, of company B first prize. A gold medal as the best cannoner. Chas. Keller Maugat delivered the presentation speech and prizes.

THE EVENING concert passed off very pleasantly and was well attended. About fifty ladies and gentlemen were present at the alumni reunion at the Gorman house after the exercises and had a pleasant social time in the parlors. The society adjourned to the dining room and partook of a sumptuous repast.
