RESULT SHOWN IN DETAIL. Congressman Lyman Re-elected and the Judicial Ticket Safe.

THE COUNTY TICKET SPLIT UP. Judge Jones and Justice Frainey Among the Wounded Taken From the Field—Tabulated Vote.

The Facts and Figures. There was much figuring over returns yesterday, they coming in unofficially and in fragments, but clearly enough to indicate the results sufficiently to satisfy the many questioners of "How has it gone?"

The Republicans will elect their judicial ticket, Carson, Thornell and Deemer by about 1,000 majority. The judicial vote in the city stands: Carson 1,202, Thornell 1,088, Deemer 1,080.

By this it appears that Frainey was most fearfully cut, not getting half of the democratic vote of the city. He will now retire from office for a season.
