SOUTH OMAHA AFFAIRS.

Special Meeting of the Council to Consider Q Street Viaduct Repairs.

All the members were present at a special meeting of the city council last night. Mayor Walker presided. The meeting was called for the purpose of taking some action in regard to the immediate repairing of the Q street viaduct, which was recently damaged by a washout.

City Engineer King stated that he had made an estimate as to what the repairs would cost. To repair the viaduct and place it in as good condition as it originally was would cost \$2,450. In addition to this it would cost \$85 to remove the stones that were damaged in that immediate vicinity. This amount would not include the cost of putting in any new catch basins or the removal of any dirt.

After some discussion as to the different methods of making the repairs, Bulla made the report of the city engineer, and adopted his plan of building three wings of stone be carried out.

Before the motion was put Clerk Ditzen read communication from City Attorney Van Duzen. The paper stated that frequent injury had been made of him as to whether or not the Union Pacific Railroad company should be held liable for the cost of the expense of the repairs on the viaduct. He stated that for the present he was not prepared to give an opinion on the matter, but would do so if the council so desired at an early day.

The points of law involved in the matter were complicated, and he desired more time for a thorough study of the case. Mr. Wyman said he thought the council should have the legal opinion of the city attorney on this matter.
