

LAWYERS WANTED BY SHERIFFS

Will Bring Their Desires to the Attention of the Legislature. TERM OF OFFICE SHOULD BE FOUR YEARS

No More Sales of Mortgaged Property by Special Masters—Reasons Given Why These Two Changes Should Be Made—Sheriff Drexel Talks

The county officials ask for the passage of but two bills, one of which is to increase the term to four years, while the other is to do away with special master commissioners...

Regarding the other bill, which is to provide for the doing away with the special master commissioner, Sheriff Drexel gives the reasons why it should become a law.

In speaking of the matter he said: "Last year in this county there were 750 forced sales of real estate, which were made by the sheriff's office, the others being handled by the special masters, appointed by the court."

"So far this year the courts have issued 135 orders of sale, six of which have come to my office, all of the others going to the special masters, and out of the 135 only 100 were made by the sheriff's office, the others being handled by the special masters, appointed by the court."

Speaking of the action of the court last Saturday, when it was stated that some of the judges were considering a plan of appointment, Sheriff Drexel said that he had never appointed any special masters, but instead he had always selected competent parties, usually business men who were in the real estate business.

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Judge Baxter decided an interesting point in the contest over the estate left by Harrison Buckner, which has been occupying the attention of the court for the last few days.
