Petition in the Short Line Case Put John M. Egan in Training.

THURSTON ARGUES FOR THE DEMURRER

Oregon and Idaho Courts Have Previously Conceded Primary Jurisdiction to the Wyoming Courts in Dealing with the Roads.

PORTLAND, Ore., March 14.—Senator John M. Thurston today argued in favor of the demurrer to American Loan and Trust company's petition against the Oregon Short Line and Utah Northern railway companies. He said the first mortgages on the original Oregon Short Line and Utah Northern were first liens on the properties, and that any subsequent mortgage was subject to these prior liens. He said judicial propriety, which the solicitors of Dillon, trustee, had no right to disregard, required that when the foreclosure suit was brought it be commenced in the state court which has primary jurisdiction. He said in these proceedings the counsel for complainant had referred time and again by innuendo, rather than by plain speaking, to errors in the order made by the federal courts from the beginning of the Ames suit down to date. He said he should never stand and criticize the actions of the federal court of his country. He said that in the Dillon case the courts of the Oregon and Idaho district conceded by their orders that the Wyoming court was the one of primary jurisdiction, and conceded that the Oregon and Idaho courts were in the case. He said he respects to Mr. Thurston's statement, that the loan and trust company did not ask for the appointment of a receiver, but that it asked for a proper court receiver, and said the petitioners had picked a receiver, naming John M. Egan, chairman of the General Managers' association, during the great strike last summer, and brought him across the continent; he had sat in the court room during all of the argument, and sat there today as "petitioner's exhibit A" in the case.
