DISTRICT COURT TAKES A REST.

Jury Discharged for the Term and Cases Left Over Tomorrow. Judge Macy finished up the criminal docket yesterday afternoon and discharged the jury for the term. He will probably return next Monday from his home in Harlan and take up the trial of the sixteen injunction cases instituted some weeks ago by J. J. Shea. All day yesterday the jury in the case of the state against John Miller, charged with subjecting a woman to an indecent exposure, without success. Judge Macy went home and the jury may have to stay out until he returns. Judge Smith is expected to arrive today, and so either he can either receive the verdict or discharge the jury in case of a disagreement. Judge Macy appointed a temporary guardian for William Weston, as asked by the latter's brother, James Weston, on the ground that there was no need of it until the purpose of a hearing. In the suit of C. G. Saunders, guardian ad litem of Fred Harting, against Charles Harting, a decision was rendered in favor of the plaintiff. Fred Harting, who was born in 1867, when Fred was insane and Charles was still of a sound mind, some property was purchased with the money of their parents (Saunders) and the latter's wife, but the understanding that he was to care for his parents and brother during the remainder of their lives. The parents are now dead, and the two brothers, both of whom are now in insane hospitals, are the only members of the family. Mr. Saunders brought suit to secure for Fred his share of the land, in order that the country may be divided for the care of Fred since his affliction. Judge Macy decided the case yesterday by awarding Fred a one-third interest in the farm of sixty acres, together with one-third of the \$252 now in the hands of the guardian from rents and profits, after taking out \$25 an attorney fees for Saunders and Fickler-Herz. John G. Woodward, assignee for Kodwies & Mathis, made his report, finding the total assets \$17,852, of which \$1,000 consisted of book accounts. The liabilities amount to \$2,275. D. C. Bell wants a mortgage for \$204 foreclosed. Hilla Allen brought suit for a divorce from Richard Allen on the ground of drunkenness. They were married in Logan, Ia., in 1873, but she claims he compelled her to take in washing instead of supporting her, and spent all the money he could get hold of in buying liquor. John C. Feschaut sues Mary and William Schierbrock of Neola to have a deed to some property which William transferred to Mary set aside, on the ground that the transfer was made for the purpose of defrauding his creditors.
