

MEIKLEJOHN WILLING TO RUN

Congressman from the Third Has a Desire to Become Governor.

HIS INTENTION OPENLY ANNOUNCED

Letters Mailed from Washington to His Friends State that He Will Not Again Be a Candidate for Congress.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18.—(Special Telegram.)—George D. Meiklejohn of the Third Nebraska congressional district has announced his candidacy for governor, letters to a large number of his friends throughout the state having been sent out yesterday to that effect. Mr. Meiklejohn has been in receipt of a great many letters urging him to allow his name to be used in connection with the gubernatorial office, but until now has been able to resist the siren. The pressure became too pronounced, however, and he is in the race to the finish. He announces that he will not be a candidate for renomination to congress, in view of his determination to run for governor. Meiklejohn seems to have a big following, in view of all the letters that have been pouring in upon him since The Bee reviewed the candidates mentioned for the place.

A new complication arose today in the caucus of republican senators, the formation having been conveyed to that body that the democrats were undecided whether they would yield committee organization to the republicans, in view of the changed condition of affairs in the last twenty-four hours.

NOT WILLING TO RETIRE.

Before the reception of the president's message the democrats had expressed a desire to have the republicans go ahead with the organization of the senate, as they were willing to admit that they were up. Now, in the face of the warlike attitude of the American people, as expressed by the president, they are not at all anxious to be the party of the senate and the caucus of republican senators was so informed.
