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THE DEMOCRATIC SITUATION.

It is generally conceded that President Cleveland will have a great deal to say in connection with the naming of the democratic candidate for president.

These are the only members of the president's official household whom it is at all likely he has any interest in as possible presidential candidates.

According to reports, ex-Governor Pattison of Pennsylvania is receiving assurances of support outside of his state.

A serious question with the democracy is whether the national convention will contain a majority for or against the free coinage of silver.

China has recognized the advantages of the Universal Postal Union to the extent of applying for admission to membership in that organization.

The council committee has decided to ask for an issue of refunding bonds bearing 4 1/2 per cent interest.
