MEATSCARE BRINGS RESULTS

Change in Packing Houses, Especially at Chicago, is Noticeable.

BIG INDUSTRY HURT, BUT WILL RECOVER

Secretary Wilson Expresses Surprise at Few Applications for Inspectors and Thinks Some Concerns Will Regret Tardiness.

WASHINGTON, August 4.—(Special.)—After October, every piece of meat that leaves a packing house or slaughter house will bear a brand and a label marked "U. S. Inspected and Passed." And according to the regulations which were issued by the secretary of agriculture the other day this brand or label will be a notification to the world that the conditions under which the meat was produced are clean, wholesome and that it was packed and slaughtered under the most careful sanitary conditions.

According to the census reports of 1903 there were 225 packing plants in the United States. The total capital invested in the industry was \$27,600,440, and the value of the annual product of these establishments reached the enormous total of \$93,814,624.

Few Apply for Inspectors. Secretaries Wilson is somewhat surprised in his examination into the conditions of the packing houses which will ask for government inspection. He has visited a half dozen cities already and has seen the march of the conditions.
