

MUTTON PRICES ARE 'WAY UP

Fork and Butter Drop Off Considerable in Price.

VEGETABLES ARE CHEAPER

Six Cars of Strawberries Will Arrive on the Omaha Market Saturday, Making Shortage Available for All.

Mutton is so scarce on the Omaha market that the packers are apportioning it out to the butchers rather than to fill orders. It is the lambing season and stock raisers are holding their sheep for later sale, the price meanwhile advancing to almost prohibitive figures.

Although butter, eggs and meats are higher, grocers say that the cost of living with which they have to do is lower than it has been for years, other people talk to the contrary notwithstanding.

Vegetables are cheaper now. Rhubarb is selling four bunches for a nickel; radishes, three for 5 cents; spinach, 10 cents a peck, that was 15 cents a week ago; fresh peas are 10 cents a quart.

Butter is 22 cents a pound for the best quality, and eggs are 20 cents a dozen. Butter will go down this month, grocers say, because the stores will be getting ready to lay in supplies for next winter.
