GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET

Heavy Cash Sales of Grain Are Reported at Chicago.

LOOK FOR PRICE SETBACK

Many Traders Are Said to Be Long and Pit Mongers Are Expecting Reaction to the Steady Rise During the Week.

OMAHA, Oct. 24, 1913. Cash sales at Chicago yesterday were 140,000 bushels of wheat, 20,000 bushels of corn and 30,000 bushels of oats. Charters were for 100,000 bushels of corn to Georgian bay at 1 1/2 cents. The seaboard report of a building market for grain has had an advance enough for the time being and they are looking for a setback as the wheat traders are ready to begin October week. The Chicago short interest has been reduced. Sentiment among the wheat traders is bullish and more traders are said to be long than for a week.

Consumption of foreign wheat in Europe continues to liberalize and the latest revised figures show no large quantities, although weekly deliveries during the eighth week ending October 18 averaged 11,000,000 bushels. The continent is taking freely for winter supplies, as a result of cheap wheat in Canada and North America are supplying the demand.

Cash wheat was 40 higher. There were 1,000,000 bushels of corn yesterday, after being a fair seller at the opening. His operations the last few days have made a profit on the advance price. The most successful traders in corn are bullish on the final options, but are disposed to go short on the advance price.
