Young Russian Jew with Passion for an Education.

ALMOST GLAD OF PERSECUTION

He Fired His Ambition and at Twenty in Free America He is Schooling Himself and a Younger Sister.

Jacques Rieur, a student at the University of Omaha, almost thanks his lucky stars that he was once a hated and persecuted Jew in Russia—when he thinks of what it drove him away from.

Though a youth of 20, his experiences are numerous and thrilling enough to enable a melodrama or a novel, yet he pursues a very even tenor and works "like the mechanic" for his education. Jacques got to America by dint of his grit, then studied for a year at the New York university, education being his passion. But New York is a costly place to live, so Jacques hit for the west. He earned his railroad fare as far as Chicago, then footed it to Omaha. Here he is established almost as comfortably as if he were an "old inhabitant."

He has matriculated at the university, has a job to pay his way, some new friends, has formed church connections and is happy and hopeful.

His Journey Begins

Born in Lithuania, Jacques attended a Talmudic school at Minsk until 12 years of age. Although Jews were denied entrance to the gymnasium classes, he studied them and passed examinations. Then he made a druggist of himself. At Kertch he was a drug clerk for two years, and left because of the persecutions. He found a job in Berlin, but having no Russian passport, had to move on.

In Paris he earned enough money to reach New York. Not only that, but he brought a younger brother and sister with him. He is now, in addition to keeping himself in college, supporting and educating his sister, whom he wants to bring to Omaha also.

"Ah, this is the place for us," says Jacques. "All we ask is a fair chance, and we get it here in this grand west—anywhere in America, but here, ah, I am very happy."

Jacques Rieur speaks seven languages—Hebrew, Russian, Polish, Bohemian, German, English, Yiddish—and understands and reads French. He is teaching a Sunday school class and is already becoming popular among his fellows. Having specialized in chemistry, he is now working toward the tanning industry.

CANVASS OF VOTERS SHOWS REGISTRATION TO BE SLOW

That the election commissioner system in Douglas county does not necessarily result in the registration taking care of itself is shown by some figures from the Sixth precinct of the Sixth ward. M. O. Cunningham has made a house-to-house canvass of that precinct and has thereby ascertained that there are 520 males over 21 years old. The registration for the precinct shows 120 registered. The vote at the primary showed something like 35. This shows that in this precinct less than one-third of the males over 21 were registered. Still less voted at the primary. No figures are obtained as to how many of the non-registered young men are naturalized.
