eratic party. My God, where is the harmony in it now! Since I came I have found you to be more densely ignorant and besotted than I thought I would find you.

You are like a lot of sheep without a shepherd. Your trusted leaders, whom you have kept in office for years have deserted you, and like cowards, they have stabbed your candidates in the back. They have wrecked your party and now they cry for harmony.

I never made a speech until ten years ago. I tended to my business as a farmer; didn't want office. Things got so rotten in South Carolina, just like they are here, that I was persuaded to help try to straighten them out. When I began to agitate I found the politics were not only rotten in my State, but had the dry rot.

The men who held the offices had been holding them for years. Everything was in control of a clique which dished out the offices like they were their private property. What sort of a fix are you in? (Voice in audience, "Same fix.") How are you going to help it? Do like we did in South Carolina. You, honest men and non-office holders, get together. If you are so cowardly as to allow the present state of affairs to continue there will be no help. You must stir the stagnant pool and get the green scum off. Watch the men you propose to elevate. See that they are pure in public and private life.

I see the same paper that wished I might pass by Lexington states in an interview with me this morning that I said to some friends last night that they ought to purge the silver element of all the old leaders, including Joe Blackburn, and get new leaders. I made no such allusion to Joe Blackburn being retired. He hasn't sold you out for a mess of pottage. He was for free silver when you elected him, and he is for free silver now. (Long applause.) The same paper states I am no Democrat.

IS A DEMOCRAT.

What is a Democrat? Jefferson said down the definition, and I have always lived up to his idea of what constituted a Democrat. My father before me was a democrat; but now these men, who have themselves turned their backs on Democratic principles, cry "harmony, harmony in the Democratic party!" There are nothing but Democrats in South Carolina, unless you count the negroes. There were never over 1000 white Republicans in the state. I advised the Democrats of South Carolina not to desert the Democratic party. I have given the strongest evidences during the past ten years that I am a Democrat, but I say now, so help me God, if Cleveland and Carlisle are to set the pace for Democracy, then I am no Democrat. (Cheers for three minutes.)

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Why, when Cleveland called Congress together in 1893 an effort was made by friends of silver who took the national platform to mean what it plainly said to get the Democratic caucus to give us some relief. New England Democrats went with the Republicans and trample on your rights. Look at your own state. Who was nominated by the Democrats for Senator? (A voice, "Joe Blackburn.") How many refused to vote for him? (A voice, "Five traitors.") You were betrayed, bamboozled and debauched. Take your physic. It will do you good. Let your Court House rings go to the State Convention and instruct your delegates to Chicago to vote for Carlisle for President, but you had better go out and hang yourselves as Judas did. What are you doing? You are paying the taxes and voting for these chronic officeholders. As I said, I am a Democrat, but what use is a party if it is going to rob you? Look at your Democratic party in Kentucky, when it was carrying the state by from 40,000 to 60,000 majority.

Bob Ingersoll said that when Kentucky went Republican he would say there was a bell. I don't think Bob carried out his pledge, but the devil has got Kentucky certain. If a man is rotten and dishonest as a man, he can not be honest as an official. You have got to go down among your rank and file and force some of your honest men out, like they did me in South Carolina. Organize; get to work right away. Get together and agree to be Democrats, and not John Sherman and Carlisle Republicans. Redeem the name of your state and wipe out the charge that you are now political prostitutes. But they tell us (simulating crying) to "stick by the old party."

God helps those who help themselves, and you've got to help yourselves, if you get any help. You think I ought to talk about silver. I've just been trying to make a frame to put the silver picture in. I want you to take this frame home with you and study it over. I will read you a little extract from a speech made by one of your former leaders (Breckenridge) at Covington.

QUOTES BRECKENRIDGE.

"Now universal trade is founded on universal money. It is impossible to conceive of the right to buy and sell wherever you can buy and sell the best without the conception of a standard of value which shall be the same in all markets and a medium of exchange which shall be universally accepted. It therefore follows that the necessary and ultimate goal of all currency legislation is precisely the same as that of all taxation legislation. In the one case it is universal free trade, in the other case it is universally accepted currency, and the same limitation must be observed. Monetary systems in the various nations are diverse. We can not separate ourselves from the world on the one hand, we can not suddenly revolutionize our own currency."

This is rot, the worst kind of rot. This from one of your former leaders, although I am glad to say that you women of Kentucky can give him his walking papers. Now he is trying to throw a pepper-box full of sand in your eyes. How did the world get along before the demonization of silver? Everybody knows that nations trade by products, money only being used in making balances. This is the kind of stuff that the tariff reformers are telling Democrats. It is Democracy rot. Your gifted Henry Waterston used to teach it. Poor Henry; he was a good free trader, and a good silver man, but when his masters got control of the Courier-Journal they made him grovel in the dirt. I would rather have taken a knife and cut my throat than to have remained in the employ of such scoundrels as that. Stand by honest newspapers. The boasted freedom of the press has disappeared. The papers have sold out bag and baggage to the same men who want to buy you. They want to divide you into two parties so that the managers can use the same means to control you. These people use the newspapers to teach you rottenness. The banks and the railroads are with them.

Tell me what business a man is in

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and I will tell you his politics. Breckenridge tells you in his speech last night not to do anything; let the financial situation remain just as it is for the present. While this apathy is manifest your property is sinking in value. [A voice, "Our mules have sunk."] Yes, your corn has sunk, your wheat has sunk and your liberty has sunk. They tell you to lay still while they finish skinning you.

Sound money [the speaker gagged, as if about to vomit, making a wry face, when a voice in the audience said, "Throw it up," and causing laughter for several minutes.] They say silver dollars are only 50c dollars. What made them? Mr. Carlisle said in his famous Memphis speech that law does not affect ratio. Suppose I have three dollars here, one paper, one silver, one gold. A merchant will take one as quickly as the other, because paper is redeemed in gold, silver is redeemed in gold. Silver used to be a dollar in itself, just like you are white men. They are dollars now by act of congress. Let's see. We'll burn these three dollars; the paper goes up in smoke; the gold melts; the silver melts. The gold is worth 100c, because by act of congress gold can be taken to the mint and recoined. The silver is worth 50c, because by act of congress it cannot be recoined. So it is law that makes all three of these dollars the same value.

They tell you that this law is bi-metallic. When they do this they take you for a lot of asses. When they tell you that this country has got more money than it ever had before, they lie. When we had 31,000,000 people, and all of us down South were as poor as church mice, we had \$1,000,000,000 of money. Now, with 70,000,000 people we have got less money than we had then.

Why are the crops so low, horses so low? The object of the gold men in demonizing silver was to get more of your labor for the same money, and thus enhance the purchasing power of their fixed incomes from bonds. I'll illustrate this. Suppose there is a plate of biscuit on this table, and two plates of butter about the same size. The butter on one plate is white, on the other yellow. The housewife picks up the plate with the white butter, smells it, says its not sound, throws it away. Now, will any body in this house tell me that there would be as much butter to put on the biscuit as if both plates had been left on the table? (Laughter.) But these Democratic harmonizers tell you to vote the Democratic ticket, no matter what platform is adopted or what the conditions of the people are. Where will you be in five years? (Voice, "In the poor house.") No, because there will be nobody to pay any taxes for poor houses. The money sharks will own your farms and will let you stay on them, but you will be in abject slavery.

Stick to your party when your party sticks to you. Be Democrats, but swear that you will have honest men in office, who will not betray their party. If you stick by Carlisle, may God have mercy on your souls! You are so unused to being whipped, that one whipping has made you cowards. If you love the Democratic party, send silver men to Chicago. We'll force the honest men to leave the Republican party, and we'll tell them we'll vote for no man for president who is not for free silver.
