### NEW FEE LAW.

Proposal to Remedy Defect in Present Statute.

Judge Thomas A. McBride arrived in Astoria on the noon train today. He came down for the purpose of consulting with District Attorney Allen regarding the new recording fee law, which is to be framed for presentation at the special legislative session, in

the event that some other general bill is not offered. Judge McBride said this afternoon that he was of the opinion fees could not be legally collected under the existing statute, the law of 1895 providing for fees for recording deeds having been inadvertently repealed. A suit for \$200 has been brought in Columbia county in Judge McBride's court, but no decision has yet been reached, and it is unlikely

ly that the court will make a ruling until after the special session.

There has been a belief that, while the county of Clatsop is really liable for the money paid in for recording deeds since 1895—a sum, by the way, that would probably exceed \$25,000—the county clerk might protect the interests of the county hereafter by declining to record deeds, unless the fees were tendered by the persons offering the deeds for record. Judge McBride was asked about this matter today, and replied that the clerk would have to accept and record deeds without receiving the fees.

The matter is one of pressing importance, and there is no question that it will be disposed of at the forthcoming special session.—Astorian.
