THE LEGISLATURE ROUTINE WORK IN

New Senate Bills.
S. B. 250, Sinnott, to allow counties to fix salaries of officers.
S. B. 251, ways and means, to appropriate \$15,000 for state fair.
S. B. 252, ways and means, to appropriate \$25,000 for sewer systems at state fair grounds.
S. B. 253, committee on medicine, to appropriate \$20,000 for construction of tuberculosis sanatorium and \$25,000 for maintenance.

Third Reading of Bills.
S. B. 247, Selling, Sailor boarding house bill. Passed.
S. B. 47, Oliver, to appropriate \$10,000 per year for the support and maintenance of the Eastern Oregon experiment station at Union. Passed.
S. B. 184, Bingham, to amend laws of 1907, relating to forest fires, and appropriating \$10,000 therefor. Passed. Barrett, Kay, Selling and Smith of Marion voted no.
S. B. 240, Wood, to require the county court of Washington county to pay 90 per cent of road tax to certain municipalities. Passed.
S. B. 236, Bailey, to require the county court of Multnomah county to submit to a vote the location of court house. Re-referred.
S. B. 243, Johnson, to raise the salary of superintendent of Benton county from \$800 to \$1000. Passed.
S. B. 3, Johnson, road law. Passed. Kay, Miller of Linn, Nottingham, Parrish, Selling, Smith of Marion, voted no.

S. B. 79, Barrett, to fix salary of recorder of Washington county. Passed, notwithstanding the veto of the governor, by a vote of 21 to 8.
S. B. 139, Sinnott, to protect persons engaged in dangerous work. After long argument by Sinnott for the bill and Miller of Linn and Lane against, Kay moved to refer to committee with instruction to amend; motion was lost. Bill failed to pass, by a vote of 17 to 11, with two absent. Those voting for the bill were Abraham, Albee, Bailey, Coffey, Kay, Kellaher, Miller of Linn, Oliver, Selling, Sinnott.

Adjourned at 12:30 to 2 p. m.
S. B. 128, Miller of Linn, to provide for the establishment of road districts. Passed.
S. B. 237, ways and means, to extend time for purchase of locks at Oregon City and appropriating \$300,000 therefor. Passed by a vote of 23 to 2.
S. B. 203, Hart, to amend code, registration of voters. Passed.
S. B. 207, Norton, to amend code, relating to levy and sale under execution. Passed.
S. B. 87, Wood, to regulate the practice of embalming. Indefinitely postponed.

S. B. 21, Kay and Johnson, to provide that any bill affecting any county alone may be submitted to the voters of that county. Passed.
S. B. 231, Oliver, to change time of holding court in Tenth judicial district. Passed.
S. B. 226, Caldwell, to prevent goats from running at large in Yamhill county. Passed.
S. B. 187, Abraham, to regulate the breeding and sale of pure-bred and grade horses. Failed to pass. Vote reconsidered and re-referred.
S. B. 242, Johnson, pertaining to salaries of officers of Benton county. Passed.
Adjourned at 11:30 p. m. until 9:30 a. m. Monday.


