LONG DISCUSSES PROPOSED LAWS

Radical Changes Contemplated to Compel Better and Cheaper Public Service

City Attorney Percy V. Long, chairman of the committee on public service legislation, outlined at length the proposed legislation for the establishment of a public service commission which will have charge of the public service corporations and will be clothed with the power to fix rates. Some radical changes in the present laws are contemplated with a view to giving the people fuller protection of their rights.

REAPPOINTMENT PLAN SUBMITTED

Tentative Scheme Would Attach Marin County to a Part of San Francisco

A tentative congressional reapportionment plan that had been approved by the California delegation in congress was presented to the reapportionment committee yesterday morning by J. O. Hayes. The scheme approved by the California delegation was drawn on the assumption that the congressional apportionment bill would be drawn to maintain the house of representatives at its present proportions. This would give California two additional members of the house.

Public Service Law Changes Broad Powers for Commission

Here is the text of the proposed constitutional amendment through the ratification of which City Attorney Percy V. Long and the members of his special committee hope to secure the desired powers for the promised public service commission and a new system of regulation for public service corporations:

Section 19 of article XI is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 19. The legislative body of any county or municipal corporation may, in its discretion and under such conditions as it may prescribe, grant franchises to occupy and use portions of the public streets or highways for the purpose of furnishing any public service. Such franchises shall be of the character known as indeterminate, shall not be granted for a term of years, but shall continue until the state or county or municipality granting the same shall elect to take over the property used in supplying any such public service and engage in the business thereof. The several counties and municipal corporations in the state are hereby authorized to engage in any business to or for which a franchise may be given. The legislature shall provide the method of determining the value of any property to be purchased by the state, county or municipal corporation and may vest in a board or commission the power to fix such valuation. Persons or corporations now engaged in any public service business may surrender any franchise now held and agree to operate under an indeterminate franchise granted as herein provided. The legislative body of any county or municipal corporation shall have the power to fix the rates to be charged and collected for any public service furnished within such county or municipal corporation, but the legislature may, in its discretion, vest the power to fix such rates in a board or commission.
