Kentucky Farmer's Peculiar Porker.

Hogs have been so high this fall that any antics they might take would hardly surprise the farmers right now, but Mr. J. E. Bruce, of the Danville pike, has a porker which is a little different from anything he or any one else ever saw in the porcine line, according to the best informed authorities. Good Roads Enthusiasm.

Interest in next week's vote on a million dollar bond issue for the construction of trunk lines of brick highways in Orange county, Florida, reflects the enthusiasm which has already placed Florida upon the high road to improved thoroughfares and is manifested in many parts of the South. In West Virginia—Mingo county has voted \$500,000 of bonds, and McDowell county will soon vote upon a bond issue of \$200,000, while a strong sentiment is developing in Meigs county for an issuance of \$500,000 of bonds to supplement with macadam roads the paved streets of such centers as Bluefield, Princeton and Branchwell. Last week Wise county, in Southwest Virginia, voted heartily on a bond issue of \$700,000 and Oklahoma county in Oklahoma voted for \$500,000 of road bonds, the proceeds of which are to be devoted to building an east and west road and a north and south road from Oklahoma City. Thirty-four counties in Texas have voted since the beginning of the year more than \$4,000,000 of road bonds while ten other counties are spending annually nearly \$1,000,000 upon public highway, not including proceeds of bond issues. There is activity, too, in Louisiana, Georgia, Mississippi, Alabama, North Carolina and other Southern states under the conviction that one of the best forms of investment of money for the state as a whole or for individuals in providing first class highways as a sure means of bringing about well rounded development of rural and urban communities.

Crossing Corn Varieties.

Experiments by the Department of Agriculture and various experiment stations have shown that the yield from crosses of two varieties or strains of corn is in almost every case materially larger than that of the parents. It has been pointed out in bulletins already published that this method of increasing the yield can be utilized in farm practice by the simple experiment of placing the strains or varieties that are to be crossed in alternation and then removing the one of the varieties. All the seed produced by the plants of the detasseled rows will be cross-pollinated and can be used for the planting of the general crop in the next season.
