LAND DECISION FAVORS RAILROADS.

Judge Charles Swayne, of the United States court, recently decided one of the most important cases before him in a number of years. It was that of the Augusta, Tallahassee and Gulf Railroad vs. the trustees of the internal improvement fund of Florida, to compel the latter to give deed to certain lands aggregating thousands of acres which had been given to the company by an act of the legislature in order to aid the construction of the Thomasville and Tallahassee railroad.

within the state to any person or company without the consent of the trustees of that fund, and that the latter had the sole custody of the same and was the only body which had a lawful right to convey or sell any of the property under its care. Judge Swayne held that the legislature had the right to transfer any lands that might lie in the state, and that it has created the board of internal improvement fund and consequently had the power to take any steps that it might see fit.

Commencing at the southwest corner of township 21 south, range 34 east, thence run east on township line to the southeast corner of section 32, township 21 south, range 35 east, thence south on the section line between sections 4 and 5 to the north line of the Delespine grant; thence north 76 degrees east along the north line of the Delespine grant to the west side of DeSoto street in Titusville; thence north along the west side of DeSoto street to the Indian river; thence southerly meandering the west shore of Indian river to a point on Indian river where the dividing line between townships 23 and 24 intersects the Indian river; thence west along said township line to west boundary of Brevard county; thence northerly along the west line of Brevard county to the point of beginning.

SECOND COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT.

Commencing on the west shore of Indian river where townships 21 and 22 intersect said river; thence east along said township line to the Atlantic ocean; thence south along the Atlantic ocean to a point in the west boundary of Brevard county; thence south along the west boundary of Brevard county to the southwest corner of Brevard county; thence east along the south boundary of Brevard county to the Atlantic ocean; thence north along the Atlantic ocean to the point of beginning.

THIRD COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT.

Beginning on the Atlantic ocean at a point two miles south of the line dividing townships 26 and 27; thence run west along said section line to the west boundary of Brevard county; thence south along the west boundary of Brevard county to the southwest corner of Brevard county; thence east along the south boundary of Brevard county to the Atlantic ocean; thence north along the Atlantic ocean to the point of beginning.

FOURTH COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT.

Commencing on the west shore of Indian river where townships 23 and 24 intersect said river; thence run west to the west boundary of Brevard county; thence south along said west boundary to the dividing line between townships 25 and 26; thence east along said township line to Indian river; thence northerly along the west shore of Indian river to the point of beginning.

FIFTH COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT.

Commencing at the southwest corner of township 21 south, range 34 east, thence run east on township line to the southeast corner of section 32, township 21 south, range 35 east; thence south on the section line between sections 4 and 5 to the north line of the Delespine grant; thence north 76 degrees east along the north line of the Delespine grant to the west side of DeSoto street in Titusville; thence north along the west side of DeSoto street to the Indian river; thence easterly across the Indian river to the point on the east shore where the township line between townships 21 and 22 intersects said east shore; thence east along said township line to the Atlantic ocean; thence northerly along the ocean beach to the north line of Brevard county; thence west to the northwest corner of Brevard county; thence south on range line between ranges 33 and 34 to the place of beginning.
