### FRANK "RED" LEWIS IN LIMBO NOW

Frank Lewis, better known as "Red" Lewis, is in trouble again. Court house attaches are talking about the legal training he is getting as defendant in the criminal court.

"Red" Lewis and his female consort "Porcupine Mary" whose real name is Mary Boyle, have caused more trouble along the Juneau waterfront than all others combined.

Mary Boyle is an Indian woman, who became white through marriage to "Chic" Boyle, an ex-soldier of Ft. Seward, and is therefore allowed to buy and drink whiskey.

For many months she and "Red" who have been living together have terrorized the community around the City dock with their drunken carousals.

"Red" Lewis has tried the patience of Captain Martin and the nightwatchmen a long time. The first time he appeared in court was on account of drawing a 45-Colt's and discharging it in the shooting gallery. He was sentenced 90 days for this, but got out early. He was mixed up in the Overman shooting which occurred during the same month, September, 1911. Three months later he was arrested for creating a disturbance at Burford's corner. He was locked up in the federal jail and during his imprisonment tried to tear the building down. He got a six months' sentence for malicious destruction of property—but served only part of the time.

He next appeared in the commissioner's court to answer to an assault case last month, and he was fined ten dollars and costs.

He was mixed up in several drunken brawls at "Porcupine Mary's" cabin during November, but was not brought to court because of it. However, he did get arrested for stealing coal and has been out under a suspended sentence for several weeks. Last night Capt. Martin caused his arrest again through the marshal's of-

He is under two separate charges for assault and battery; one committed at the Montana saloon; the other at the cabin home of Mary Boyle, No. 12, Roberts' Row. When arrested he was found with Mary at her home.

This morning Lewis was conducting his own defense very cleverly before Judge Winn, in the last mentioned case.

It is said that the charge of unlawful cohabitation will also be laid against him and brought to the attention of the grand jury. Friday, Dec. 13, was an unlucky day for "Red."
