**NEW CODES FOR
ALASKA IN TYPE**

A cable message from his secretary, Mr. Jeffrey, received by Delegate Wickersham, brings the information that the new codes for Alaska, comprising three volumes, have now been put in type and that proofs in the rough have been mailed to the Delegate here in Juneau.

The new codes were prepared as the joint action of the House and Senate Committees on Territories. This new code in three volumes is to displace the Carter Code entirely and has been prepared largely through the assistance of Delegate Wickersham and contains everything up to the last minute in the matter of Congressional law-making for Alaska. It is the desire of the Delegate to have the proof sheets of the new code presented to the Legislative Assembly of Alaska as a guide in the matter of passing new laws. An appropriation of \$10,000 has been made to pay for the printing of this new code which will mark the end of Congressional law-making for the territory. There is also an appropriation to cover the expense of printing the laws passed by the present Legislature of Alaska which will be known as volume 1, of the session laws of the Territory of Alaska.
