VIVID STORY OF THRILLING PLOT

The "Prisoner of Zenda" films that will appear at the Gross Theatre tonight tell in vivid fashion the story of Rudolf Rassendyll, a young Englishman in whose veins flows the same blood as that of his relative Rudolf, King of Ruritania. This has resulted in a startling physical resemblance between the two.

Duke Michael, a cousin of the King, known as "Black Michael," is plotting to secure the throne for himself and to marry the Princess Flavia. Rassendyll, who, finding the hotels of Strelsau, the capital, overcrowded, due to the coming coronation, has ordered lodgings at an inn in the village of Zenda. He goes to Ruritania to see his distant cousin crowned. But "Black Michael" has drugged the King and imprisoned him in a dungeon at Zenda. His loyal followers persuade Rassendyll to accept the crown tem-

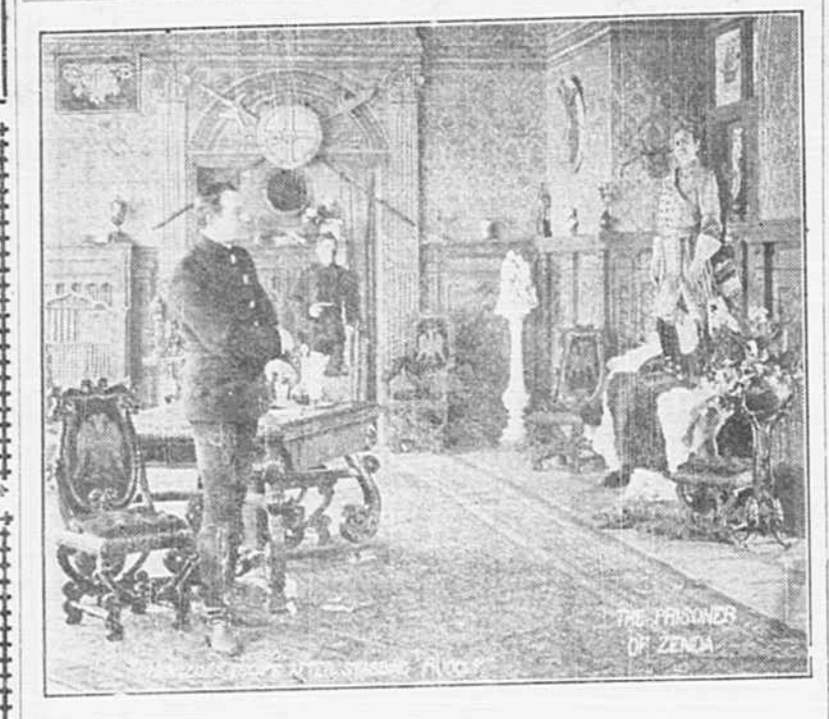
RICH SWITZERS COMMIT SUICIDE

porarily to thwart "Black Michael." The latter is suddenly confronted and confused by the presence of Rassendyll, whose resemblance to the King deceives his ambassadors and ministers, and who is readily accepted as the Royal Rudolf.

Instantly Falls in Love.
 In the meantime Rassendyll meets the Princess Flavia, who immediately observes a subtle contrast in his sturdy, wholesome, attractive qualities from the selfish and self-indulgent proclivities of the King. She forces herself to realize that the real King has undergone a great change in the last few days. Gradually she elapses to love him—and Rudolf falls instantly in love with the gentle Flavia.

From that moment a series of thrilling plots and counterplots follow each other in rapid and stirring sequence. The attempt of Michael and his men to kill the King, the entrance of Rassendyll into the dungeon at Zenda, where he finds the Royal Rudolf in a state of mental agony and physical collapse, the wounding of Rassendyll through treachery, the killing of "Black Michael," are told in a series of lucid and effective tableaux.

The final scene between Rassendyll and the Princess Flavia is dominated by a gentle touch of sentiment, mingled with pathetic hopelessness, when Rudolf tells here is not the King. They part because "love is not all."

NO SUB-PART AT FAIRBANKS THIS YEAR

The sub-part of entry that it was authorized to establish at Fairbanks this year will not be created, for the reason that the necessity for it has been obviated by the determination of the White Pass to operate American boats on the lower Yukon. The Alaska and Yukon, belonging to that company and built for use below Dawson, are both American craft. While they were put together at Whitehorse, all the machinery and other material that went into their construction came from the United States. It was assembled at Whitehorse and put together there.

If a Canadian boat should make a trip down the Yukon below Eagle it will carry an American customs conveyance from the boundary line to its destination.
