TARIFF LAW NOT CAUSE OF DEFICIT

The New York Tribune, a Republican paper of standing, has taken notice of the attorney's charge that the new tariff law responsible for the deficiency in the revenues of the government, which it repudiates.

"Nothing could be more unfair than to attribute the present collapse of Treasury receipts to the tariff law, and nothing could be more foolish than to inject a tariff argument into any special measure aimed to provide more revenue in the emergency which has grown out of the war in Europe.

"If the ships to carry the traffic can be put into service obviously we shall be doing all selling and no buying; so that if the foreign markets are open to us and if we have the ships to get into them, we not only shall save our favorable balance of foreign trade, after it seemed utterly lost to us under the new tariff, but again pile it high in our favor."
