

A shaft has recently been finished at the Ronchamp Colliery, in Haute-Saone, France, which is 3,314 ft. deep. The work of sinking was commenced in 1896, and over five years was occupied in completing the shaft to its present depth. The temperature at the bottom of the shaft, as taken recently, is 116 degrees, when that at the surface was 59 degrees, showing an increase of 57 degrees, or 1.72 degrees for each 100 ft. of depth.—Engineering and Mining Journal.
