### BOARD OF EQUALIZATION FILING OF APPEAL BY PERSON ASSESSED

Notice of appeal, in writing, specifying the grounds for the appeal, shall be filed with the Board within 30 days after the date on which the assessor's notice of assessment was given to the person appealing. Such notice must contain a certification that a true copy thereof was mailed or delivered to the assessor. If notice of appeal is not given within that period, the right to appeal shall cease to any matter within the jurisdiction of the Board, unless it is shown to the satisfaction of the Board that the taxpayer was unable to appeal within the time

so limited.

A copy of the notice of appeal must be sent to the assessor as above indicated.

Forms may be obtained at City Hall in duplicate, and must be returned before April 15, 1960. (Section 18, Chapter 174, Session Laws of Alaska 1957.)
