

Joseph Loughran Dies In Seattle

Joseph Michael Loughran, 81, died July 19 of a heart attack at his home in Seattle. Mr. Loughran and his wife, Elizabeth Sundberg Loughran, lived in Kodiak many years. Mr. Loughran operated Kodiak's first laundry, which was located where the Variety Store is at present. He later owned and operated Dad's Liquor Store.

Mr. and Mrs. Loughran moved to Anchorage several years ago where they operated a trailer court. Three years ago they went to Seattle where they operated the Chief Seattle Motel.

Mr. Loughran, born in Scranton, Pa., first came to Alaska in the early 1900's and was at one time a prospector and miner.

He is survived by his wife, a son, Joseph Jr., a step-son, Chris A. Anderson, and five grandchildren, all of Seattle.

Requiem Mass and funeral services were held July 22 at the Russian Orthodox Church in Seattle,

with burial in the Russian Orthodox Cemetery.
