The Rotarians and guests at the Rotary Club luncheon Tuesday at the 49 Room were given an eyewitness account of events occurring throughout the world today and warned that unless we as a nation remain strong our civilization is in danger of being wiped

The speaker, Mr. Ford O. Elvidge, former governor of Guam, and a visiting Nile Temple dignitary, speaking to the group on the U. S. and world tensions which prevail today, stated that only as a strong nation can we counteract the influence of the communist philosophy, which he said represented a real threat in the world today. "We need to be strong militarily," he said, "but also morally." He cited remarks by J. Edgar Hoover, who said the U.S. was becoming morally decadent. Elvidge said we pay less attention to law preservation than we do to law enforcement.

Elvidge cited examples of other nations who have built up their economy after the war, largely through the Marshall plan. "We have made competitors out of the peoples of the world. These have affected our own markets,"


