

## Big Hallowe'en Party Set For Monday

The children and the younger teen-agers in the town of Kodiak are again going to take part in the world's biggest and best Hallowe'en party. This will be the 4th year that boys and girls here will make their rounds, in costumes, to collect for the world's needy children instead of for themselves. Instead of defacing or destroying property, they will actually be helping to destroy disease and malnutrition throughout the world. This new style Hallowe'en is sponsored by the United Nations Children's Fund, the largest cooperative effort ever made to bring health to boys and girls in far parts of the world who are desperately in need of food and health

care. The idea of coins for UNICEF was started by a group of young people in 1950—so this is the 10th Anniversary. It has been spreading like wild-fire ever since. The first UNICEF Hallowe'en in Alaska was 5 years later, in 1945.

Children will be given their MILK CARTONS with a UNICEF marker on it, in their churches on Sunday, or they can be picked up at the Community Baptist Church on Sunday or Monday—and will start on their collecting in their assigned areas after school on Monday (Hallowe'en). Children up through the 5th grade will return their boxes to the Kodiak Christian Center between 6:30 and

7:30 p.m. and have their party there. Sixth graders up will return their boxes to the Community Baptist Church between 7:30 and 8:30 and have their party there.

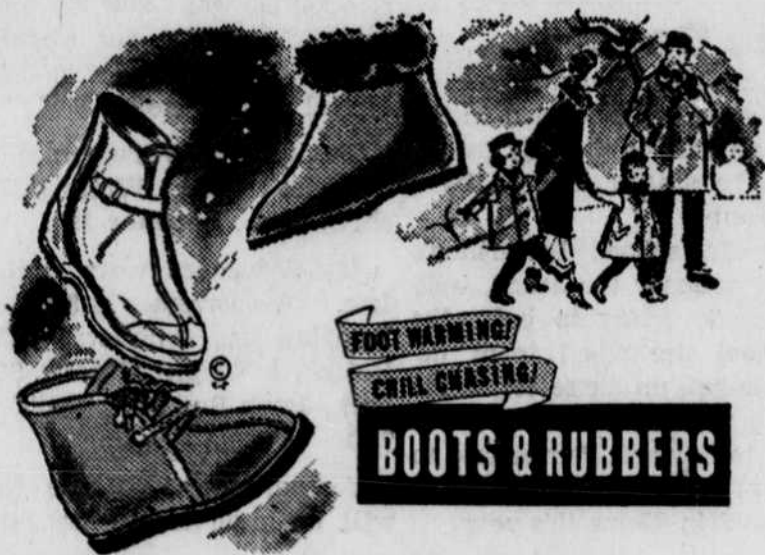
