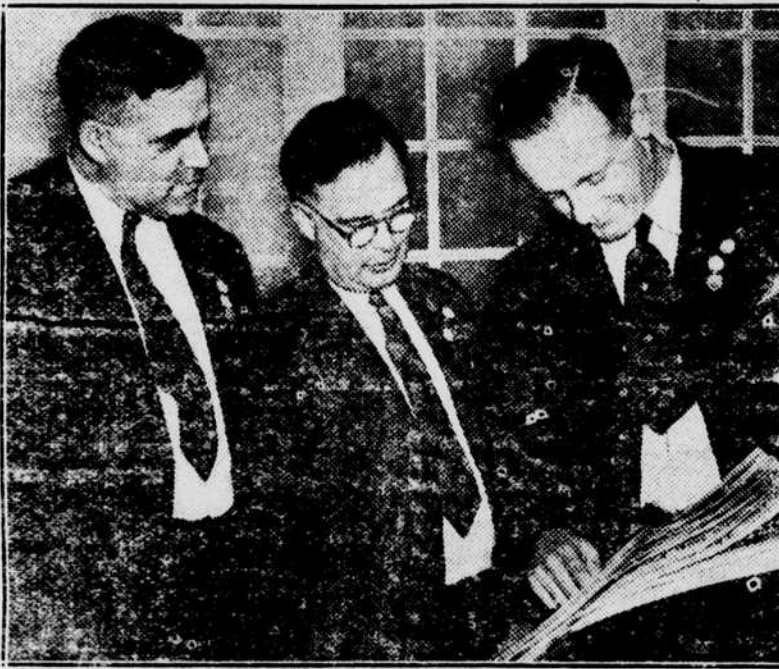

Delegates Gather Discuss the Sugar Industry World

LONDON, April 2—Delegates from twenty two countries assembled here today to seek an international five year plan to stabilize the world's billion, three hundred million dollar sugar industry, in a desire to coordinate production and sale, exporting and producing.

Session are to open Monday. Japan declined to send a delegation.
