JAPS LANDING BEHIND PORT ARTHUR

Big fleet of transports seen making for Gulf of Liao Tung to join forces that disembarking at Zudder bay.

Chefoo, March 5.—Six Japanese cruisers and ten transports were sighted yesterday steaming in the direction of the Gulf of Liao Tung. The movement has been connected with the reported intention to effect a landing in Zudder bay. It is said that owing to the heavy weather it is difficult for the disembarkation to proceed.

A land battle is expected at any moment.

Zudder bay is north and west of Port Arthur, and not so close to that town as Society bay where several unsuccessful attempts have been made to make a landing.

RUSSIA WILL BE LOOKED AFTER

JAPANESE LANDING TROOPS AT CHINAMPO

Paris, March 5.—Information from official sources in Korea confirms previous reports to the effect that Chinampo is now free from the Japanese. The Japanese have accordingly ceased debarking troops at Chemulpo and have taken advantage of the opening of Chinampo to land troops there, thus expediting the forward movement of the troops.
