MEETING OF THE COUNCIL.

**Tax Collectors' Receipt Books to be
Handed Them Thursday.**

At the usual weekly meeting of the city council last night there were present President Hislop, Messrs. Keelar, O'Brien, Guthrie and Clancy. Mr. Keelar, on behalf of the finance committee, to which had been referred the business of collecting the assessments, submitted a form for a "quarterly tax and license receipt," and pointed out that these blanks could be used for peddlers' licenses as well as for receipts for taxes. There followed some conversation in regard to peddlers, and it was resolved to tax every one of them. The form submitted by the finance committee was accepted, and these receipt books are to be in the hands of the collectors on Thursday, so that they will be able to report and make return at next Monday's meeting. It was resolved that the money so collected, pending the absence of Treasurer Kalem, should be placed in the hands of President Hislop.
