3000 Tons Fire Bombs Dumped On Japan

GUAM, July 13 — (AP) — More than five hundred Superfortresses spilled three thousand tons of fire and demolition bombs on Tokyo Bay oil center and four Jap cities, after Navy and Marine planes had battered the big naval air station and factories, also rail lines at the south end of the enemy homeland.

Senator Mitchell Says Alaska Must Be Supplied From Government Stores

WASHINGTON, July 13—(AP)—Alaska must be supplied critical foods from government stores to avoid interference with the war effort, Senator Mitchell contends. He made public a letter to the Agriculture Secretary Anderson protesting the cancellation of Alaska's allotment of butter, cheese and canned fish from the stores.

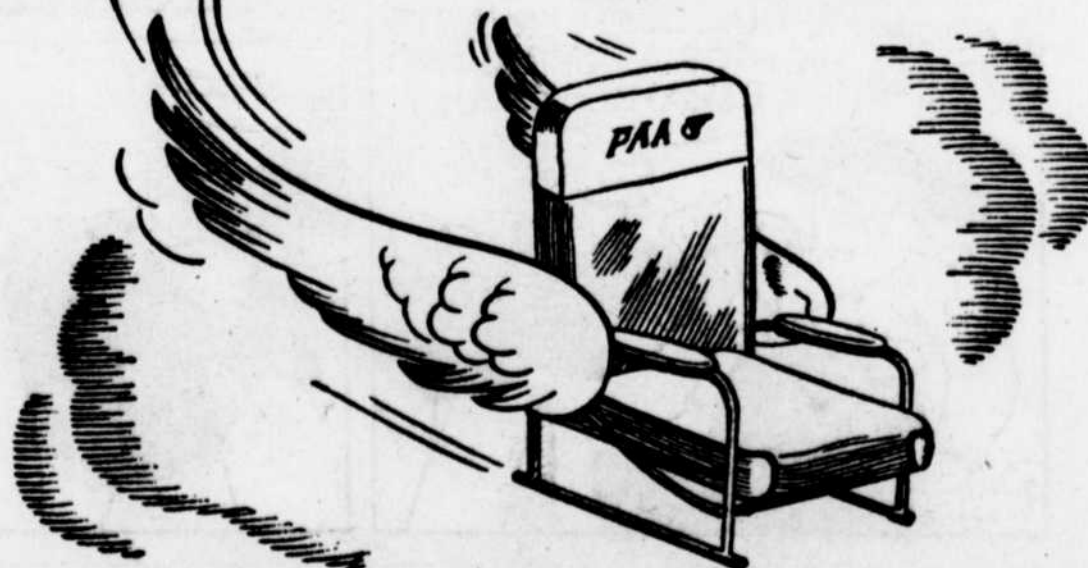
