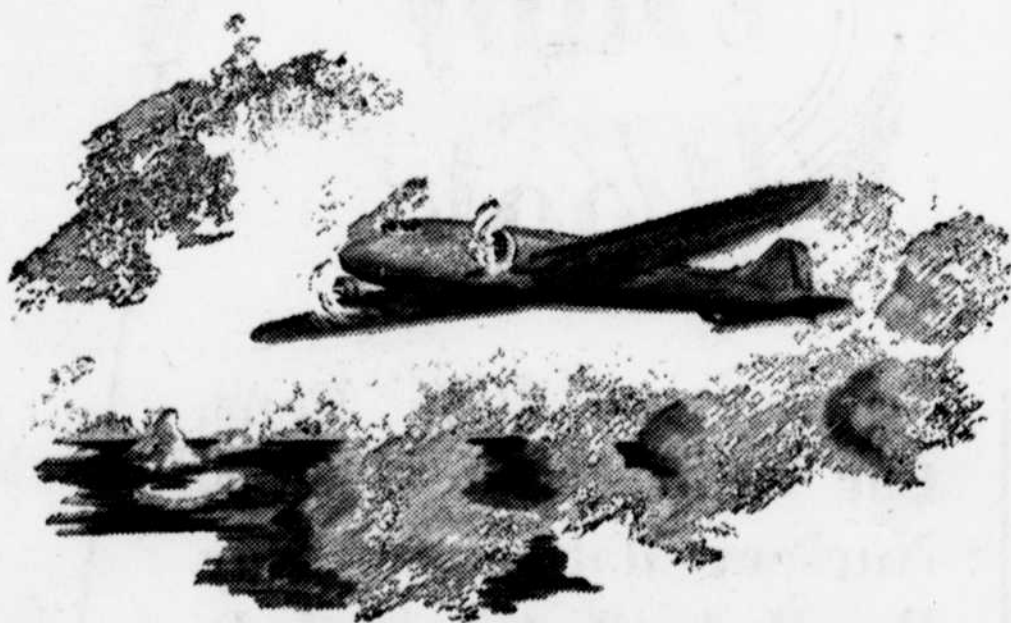

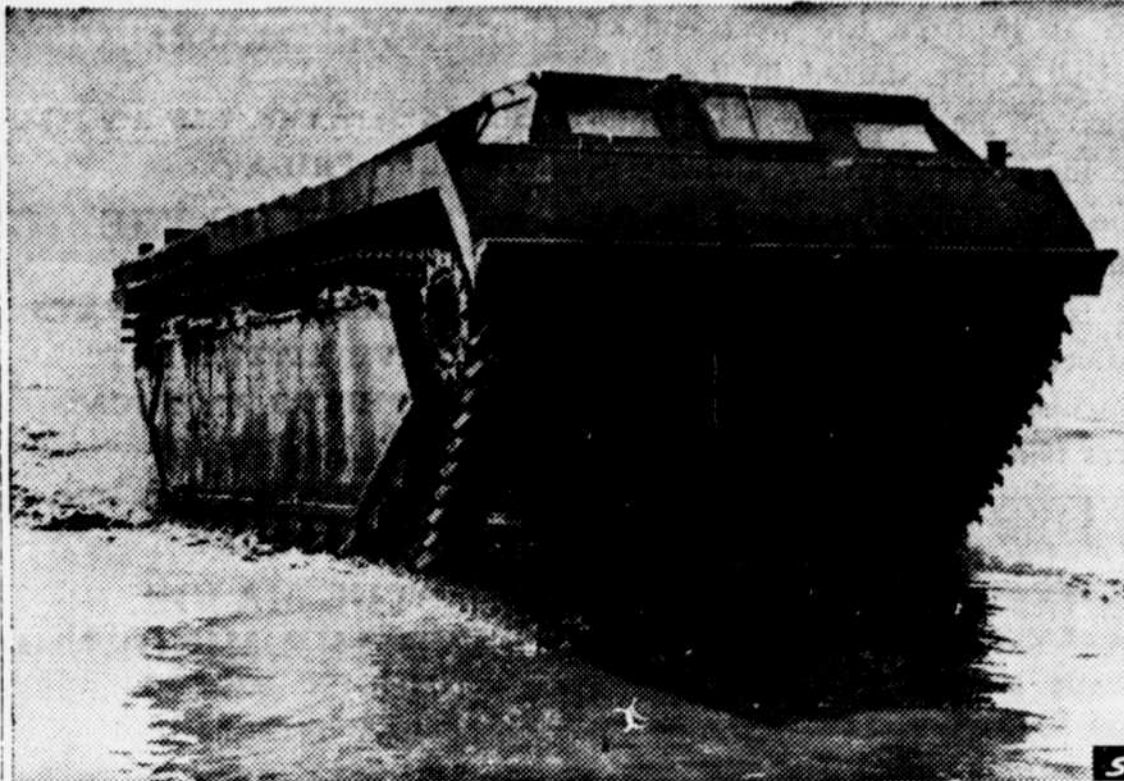

LT. COL. ALBRECHT APPOINTED HEALTH COMMISSIONER

Under the rejuvenated Territorial Department of Health act passed by the last legislature, Lt. Col. C. Earl Albrecht, recently released from the Army, began his duties this month as Alaska's first full-time Commissioner of Health with Headquarters at Juneau. He succeeds Dr. C. C. Carter of Juneau, who had headed the department on a part-time basis since the death of the late Dr. W. W. Council.

Dr. Albrecht was born June 25, 1905, near Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, of American parents. His father was a pioneer clergyman in western Canada until 1911 when they returned to the United States to establish their home in South-central Minnesota.

Dr. Albrecht is a member of the American Medical Association, The Territorial Medical Association, The American Neisserian Society, Junior Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a Diplomat of the National Board of Medical Examiners and a member of the American Public Health Association.
