

LT. COL. ALBRECHT APPOINTED HEALTH COMMISSIONER

Under the rejuvenated Territorial Department of Health act passd by the last legislature, Lt. Col. C. Earl Albrecht, recently released from the Army, began his duties this month as Alaska's first full-time Commissioner of Health with Headquarters at Juneau. He succeeds Dr. C. C.
