PAN AMERICAN REPORTS ON JUNE AIR TRAVEL

SEATTLE, July 11, — Air travel between Seattle and Alaska is continuing to climb, with 2,559 persons flying by Pan American Clippers during June, J. D. Fessio, Traffic Manager, said today. This figure is slightly higher than in

May, and 226 percent over the same month last year.

"Up until the present time, only a small percentage have been tourists, the bulk comprising essential traffic," Fessio said. Travel agencies have not been asked to encourage tourist travel to the extent of displacing regular business and family travel necessary for Alaska's welfare."

A party of eight which flew north last week-end on a 60-day trip is the largest group of tourists Pan American has handled this year, according to Fessio.

"These reservations were made last year, before the great increase in Alaska travel had become evident," he said. "We will continue to handle only a small percentage of tourists until we have taken care of our Seattle and Alaska customers who utilize air transportation as a speedy and vital method of transacting their business."

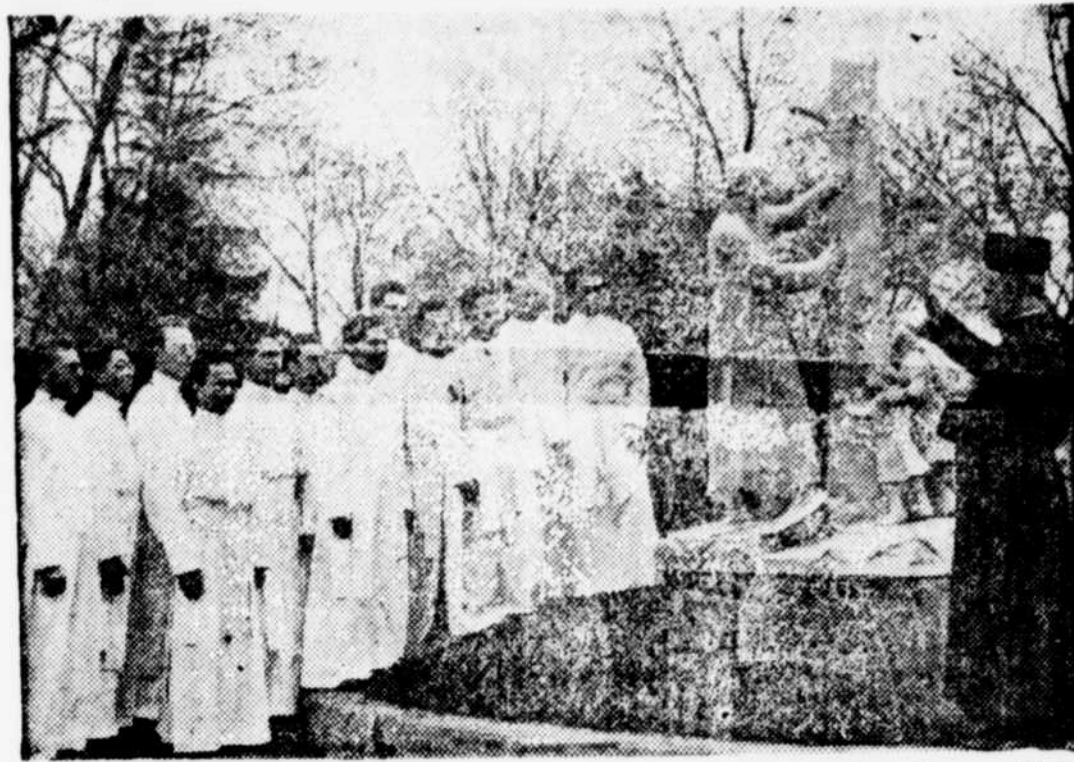
